SPECIAL THANKS The Chamber sincerely appreciates the flexibility and commitment to our members of Cindy Hollowood, Joanne Kirkpatrick and staff at the Holiday Inn as well as Alyssa Dion, Rita Cox and Kathleen Anderson of Vapor Nightclub. Both properties, on very short notice, were able to host the April and June mixers after they had to be relocated. The poolside event at the Holiday Inn and the nightclub atmosphere of Vapor at Saratoga Gaming were enjoyed by over 400 members.

STATE LEGISLATION Proposals to grant up to twelve weeks of paid family leave to employees due to extended family illness or recuperation was opposed by your Chamber. The proposed legislation could create havoc in small business firms, and the pay would be taken out of the employer paid disability insurance fund. State leaders and all county based state legislators were contacted.

SUMMER VISITOR TROLLEY The service began on June 26, and this year will operate seven days a week. Working with Saratoga County CDTA, Board members Michael Ingersoll (The LA Group) and Don McElroy (DCG Development) and CDTA director Ray Melleady your Chamber was able to take over the trolley advertising sales; thereby saving local advertisers a good number of dollars.

TECHNOLOGY AND SARATOGA A visiting team of AMD executives met at the Chamber with area school superintendents and college presidents to discuss skills the company would like to see in graduates. The meeting was prior to the forum organized by your Chamber to update members on the development of the Luther Forest Campus and the NYSERDA Campus adjacent to Luther Forest. The Center for Economic Growth also presented a report on the economic impact of a chip fab plan, and AMD answered questions from members.

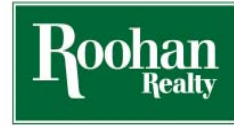

EMPLOYMENT OF MINORS CHART

Setting the Limits for Employment of Minors

With summer underway, now is a good time to review the permitted hours of work for minors under New York Labor Law. The following chart provides you with general guidance.

School in Session				
Age	Industry	Maximum Daily Hours	Maximum Weekly Hours	Permitted Hours
14 & 15	All except farm, newspaper and street trades	3 hrs. Mon. – Fri. 8 hrs. Sat., Sun., & Holidays	18 hours	7 a.m. - 7 p.m.
16 & 17	Same	4 hrs. Mon.- Thurs. 8 hrs. Fri., Sat., Sun., & Holidays	28 hours	6 a.m. - 10 p.m.
School not in Session				
14 & 15	Same as above	8 hours per day	40 hours	7 a.m. - 9 p.m.
16 & 17	Same	8 hours per day	48 hours	6 a.m. - midnight

- School is "Not in Session" when it is closed for at least a full week.
- Minors under 16 may not work in factory operations areas. Factory offices are okay.
- Working papers are generally required for those under 18 years of age.
